Results of National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy 2025 Years 3, 5, 7 & 9

In March this year, our Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 students sat for the compulsory National Assessment Program on Literacy and Numeracy for all Australian students in these year levels.

These tests results from the National Literacy and Numeracy tests will provide the schools, parents and students an important measure of how Australian students are performing in the content strands of Numeracy, Reading, Writing, Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation. At Trinity Lutheran College, our Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 teachers prepared the students through extensively scoped and sequenced units of work.

With Trinity students achieving better results in all areas compared with our state counterparts tabulated below, it is testament to the teaching practices and the well-constructed curriculum on offer at Trinity.

B. Percentage of Students Achieving Developing, Strong or Exceeding

Student achievement in NAPLAN is reported using proficiency standards for each assessment area at each year level. There are four proficiency levels:

- Exceeding: the student's result exceeds expectations at the time of testing.
- Strong: the student's result meets challenging but reasonable expectations at the time of testing.
- **Developing:** the student's result indicates that they are working towards expectations at the time of testing.
- Needs additional support: the student's result indicates that they are not achieving the learning
 outcomes that are expected at the time of testing. They are likely to need additional support to
 progress satisfactorily.
